

### Q1 How would you rate the general health of our community?

# Q2 In the following list, what do you think are the three most serious health concerns in our community?(Select 3 that apply)










Q8 In the past three years, was there a time when you or a member of your household thought you needed health care services but did NOT get or delayed getting medical services? (If no, skip to question 10)

## Q9 If yes, what were the three most important reasons why you did not receive health care services? (Select 3 that apply)



# Q19 In the past three years, have you or a household member seen a health care specialist (other than your primary care provider/family doctor) for health care services?



# Q24 In the past three years, have there been periods of at least three consecutive months where you felt depressed on most days, although you may have felt okay sometimes?





# Q25 Over the past month, how frequently have you participated in physical activity for at least 20 minutes?









# Q30 Are you aware of programs that help people pay for health care expenses?





### Q31 Where do you currently live by zip code?


